Report on the Commission on the Status of Women

by Sheila Louder - March 10-21 I joined 18,000 attendees at the hybrid 69th session of The **Commission on the Status of Women**. Main Focus: A Review and Appraisal of the implementation of the Beijing Platform for action and the outcomes of the 23rd special session of the General Assembly. The 2-week session allowed participants to hear presentations from women from around the world. Consultation Day, March 9th highlighted the fact that although progress has been made to improve the lives of women and girls UNFORTUNATELY that progress is being ROLLED back. A review by The Commission shows that the 17 Sustainable Development Goals to be reached by 2030 still require aggressive work and persistence to achieve. The question is "**What are You Willing to do to Achieve the goals?** The most interesting parallel event was "Women's Clothing and the Impact on Women's Gender Achievement"! It showed how even dress lengths impacted the

success or failure of women's advocacy! Let's review our advocacy work as women working together to achieve better lives toward 2030!!
